Dear Parents,

I hope you had a wonderful and blessed Easter as well as an enjoyable family Easter break. It is hard to realize that there are only nine weeks of school left. These weeks will fly by and are interspersed with many special school events. Please read the weekly e-blasts to keep up to date with what is happening.

We began the standardized testing program yesterday. All students in grades 2 through 8 will complete the IOWA Assessment. Grades 2, 4, and 6 take a shortened form of the assessment and the CogAt Abilities Assessment. All grades should be completed by Tuesday, April 18th. Any child absent during testing will make it up as soon as he/she returns to school, since all tests must be mailed by Friday, April 20th. Please see the letter sent in the March 28th e-blast regarding the assessments, if you have any questions.

Race for Education is next Friday, April 20. This is our biggest fundraiser and we thank those who have supported us and the very hard-working committee members. By agreeing to the fundraising portion of the contract, your letters have enabled us to keep our tuition one of the lowest in the Archdiocese and help us with facility needs.

Dismissal will be 12:10. Since we use both the school lot and St. John's lot for the race, no one will be allowed onto these parking areas until 11:50. **Therefore it is imperative that people who arrive early park on the church lot!** Please make sure whoever is picking up your children on Race Day knows to park on the church lot if they arrive earlier than 11:50. Also make sure your child knows he/she is to walk to the church lot. There is no place to queue up on Manns or Neifeld during the race time.

It has been noticed that some parents are making U-turns on Neifeld Ave after dropping off their students. This is an accident waiting to happen. The minute that it would take to circle through the parking lot ensures all drivers and students are safe. Congratulations to the Concert Band and Symphonic Band. They were awarded Excellent and Superior, respectively at the March 25th Band Festival. They each presented 2 pieces and based on what I heard, do not miss the Spring Concert! They were masterful!
