## Dear Parents,

Thank you so much for your time and effort making our Race for Education a big success again. As of this writing we are well on our way to achieving our goal. Please remind those to whom you sent letters that it is never too late to contribute. The Race itself will be held next Friday, April 12. I know the committee would appreciate volunteers for a range of jobs. This will also be an early dismissal day (12:10pm).

As of today, all grades, with the exception of one, have completed the IOWA/CogAt testing. Second grade will end testing tomorrow. Thank you so much for ensuring your child(ren) came to school after a good night's sleep and eating a good breakfast. It definitely made a difference. Also we appreciate your help in making sure all were in school in a timely fashion. We will continue to do make-ups for those who were sick through next Thursday.

The state Boost scholarship application process closes April 17<sup>th</sup> at midnight. If you qualify and are already attending St. Ursula School you could receive \$1000-\$1400 based on this year's allocations. If you know someone attending a public school, qualifies, applies, and is accepted at St. Ursula, their amount could be substantially more. In May, you will be required to pay the Instructional Fee through FACTS. This had been referred to as the Book Fee. Yet books are just a small portion of the items purchased. The Instructional Fee is being increased to \$300 (grades 1-8) and \$225 (grades PreK-K). The breakdown of this amount is:
