- Purchase more tickets at the ticket booths – cash and credit cards accepted
- It's not too late – you can buy tickets for the special children's raffles during the Thursday festival hours – winners are drawn before school ends that day
- Bring your friends – Friday and Saturday nights are open to everyone!
- Additional games on Friday & Saturday, plus a new Beer Garden for adults
- One-Ticket Games: Cake wheel, Needle in a Haystack, Apple Picking, Large Plush wheel
- Winner-Every-Time Games: Duck Pond, Fish 'til You Win, Trick or Treat, String Pull, Pumpkin Toss, Plinko, Needle in a Haystack, Apple Picking, Lollipop Stop, Spin Art
- Hit the Pumpkin Patch in the lunchroom on Thursday – this closes on the weekend when pumpkins are gone
- Bid on Silent Auction items all 3 days – bids begin closing at 8pm on Saturday and you don't need to be present to win
- Don't skip the Book Room, located just outside the gym entrance – great bargains on summer reading books and other favorites, plus buy a bag to hold your goodies
- Saturday Closing Sales – in the last hour of the Festival, listen for special markdowns on books, food, and special deals on some games/wheels
