Students will be given different assignments based on grade levels ranging from delivering mail to the middle school teachers, sitting with the first graders at Mass, to assisting the primary grade students during lunch and recess.

Two situations arise for fifth grade students, who also have the option to attend the Leadership Program.

- If a student <u>only</u> wants to be a Husky Helper. The student will need to attend the <u>two</u> Husky Helpers workshops, and <u>not</u> participate with the Leadership Workshop.
- If a student wants to be a Husky Helper <u>and</u> participate with the Leadership Workshops to be eligible for Student Council and Safety Patrol next year in sixth grade, then the student must attend all workshops as stated in the letter regarding the Leadership Program. Fifth graders are <u>not</u> required to attend the two workshops sponsored by the Husky Helpers.

For those who will attend the Husky Helpers workshops: There will be two workshops offered after school throughout the year.

Problem Solving	Monday, March 4th or Wednesday , March 6th

Each workshop will last from 3:00 pm until 4:00. The location of the workshop will be announced on the day of the meeting. Please keep this schedule. Students will not be sent additional reminders. If you are interested in participating in this series and the activities, please complete the attached form and **return it to us by Wednesday**, **October 3rd**. All students must remain in good academic standing and display good behavior to remain a Husky Helper.
