FAITH FORMATION

- "Saint for the Week": Saint Juan Diego. Juan Diego was visited by the Virgin Mary in the northern portion of Mexico City in December 1531. During these visits, Mary asked Juan to go to the bishop and request that a chapel be built in her honor, to help those that pray to her and those in need. The bishop was hesitant to believe so he asked for a sign to which Mary agreed. She then told Juan to collect flowers from the hill to take them to the bishop. Juan collected the flowers and then brought them to the bishop. When he opened his cloak to present the flowers, they poured out and leaft behind an imprint of the Virgin Mary upon his tilma (cloak). The bishop saw the image and was convinced it was a miracle. Thus, he ordered the building of the church on the hill of *Tepeyac*—at the precise location where the current-day basilica is situated in Mexico City. Juan Deigo's faith helped to make the shrine a reality. Each year, millions of people come from all over the world to visit The Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe to view the image of Mary that has remained intact and undeterred by time for 489 years. Juan Diego was canonized on July 31, 2002 by Pope John Paul II and his feast day is celebrated on December 9. He is recognized as the patron saint of indigenous people.
