### FAITH FORMATION

- "Saint for the Week": Saint Nicholas. Nicholas was born to a wealthy family in what is today Turkey in the latter part of the third century. When he grew up, he became the Bishop of Myra—a city in Asia Minor. Nicholas' legend is of many stories of his gift giving. A favorite legend about Nicholas has to do with his gifts to three sisters. At that time, a woman had to have a dowry if she wanted to get married. These three sisters had no dowry. Hearing about this, Nicholas twice went to the home of the sisters and tossed the three money sacks through the open window. By the time he came for the third sister, the father had locked the windows and stood guard to find out who was generously giving this gold. As Nicholas did not want to recognized for his actions, he instead went around the house and threw the third bag of gold down the chimney. Nicholas serves as the patron saint of children and his feast day is celebrated this Sunday, December 9.
