- <u>Saint for the Week</u>: <u>Saint Boniface</u>. As we continue our yearlong study of "Our Friends in High Places", this week our community celebrated the life of Saint Joan of Arc. The following offers a few highlights about her life:
 - o Born in England in 680.
 - He was a gifted teacher and had an attractive personality, and was ordained a priest at the age of 30.
 - He traveled to Germany, where he journeyed and evangelized the faith to the people throughout the countryside and cities.
 - Boniface is recognized as the patron saint of Brewers and Tailors and his feast day is June 5.
 - o Boniface went on to systematically evangelize central Germany, founding churches, formed dioceses, organizing the hierarchy and established a number of monasteries as centers of learning and faith.
 - At the age of 73, he returned to the mission fields, finding new people who had not yet encountered the Gospel. One evening, his encampment was attacked by pagans, and he was the first killed as a Christian martyr
