- <u>Family Service Hours</u>: As we are not permitted to have volunteers in the building and the majority of fundraising events are in a holding pattern, we have temporarily suspended service hours and will reduce your total commitment by 8 hours. - <u>Scantron Testing</u>: As you may or may not know, schools within the Archdiocese of Baltimore will no longer administer the IOWA tests. Instead, we will now use *Scantron* as our educational testing tool. This test will be comprised of four subject area tests and will take approximately one hour to complete each of these tests. Please note that the test is untimed so all students are able to take the test with their assigned cohort group. Please note that remote learners will take the *Scantron* at home at the same time that our in-person learners will take their test at school. Please refrain from scheduling any doctor's appointments during administration of the test that will occur over the following four days:
 - Tuesday, September 29 MATH
 - Wednesday, September 30 **READING**
 - Thursday, October 1 ELA
 - Friday, October 2 SCIENCE



- **<u>Parent-Student Reunification Drill</u>**: Is scheduled for Monday, September 28. As we will evacuate the building as part of our drill, please note that there will be <u>NO</u> Afternoon Care services available on this day. Additional information will be sent home in a forthcoming email.
