# "Act and God will act!" St. Joan of Arc

### FAITH FORMATION

- <u>Saint for the Week</u>: <u>Saint Joan of Arc</u>. As we continue our yearlong study of "Our Friends in High Places", this week our community celebrated the life of Saint Joan of Arc. The following offers a few highlights about her life:
  - o Born: 1412 in Domremy, France
  - Joan was around 12 years old when she had a vision where Michael the Archangel told her that she was to lead the French in a battle against the English.
  - As a result of these visions, at the age of 16, Joan led an attack against the English
    where during one of the battles, she was wounded by an arrow and yet still she
    would not stop fighting and would inspire the troops to fight even harder.
  - The English troops would retreat from Orleans as she and the French Army won a great victory and saved the French from the English.
  - Years later, the English had captured her and held Joan as prisoner. They would eventually sentence her to death as Joan was burned alive at the stake.
  - O She was only nineteen years old when she died in 1431.
  - Joan of Arc is recognized as the patron saint of France and her feast day is May 30.
