

## High School Placement Test

- \* Standardized timed test, required of each 8<sup>th</sup> grade student applying to attend a Catholic high school in AOB
- \* Two sections measure verbal and quantitative ability
- \* Three sections related to reading comprehension, mathematics, and the components of written language
- \* Students have taken pre-HSPT
- \* HSPT Prep Course -- see flyer

## **HSPT** Statistics

Class of 2024 From Pre-HSPT  $\rightarrow$  HSPT Average change in National Percentile Ranking: 0.4%  $\downarrow$ Majority of students experienced %ile change of -6 to +7%



## **Pre-HSPT Statistics Comparison**

#### Class of 2024

- \* Mean: 58.8th %ile
- \* Median: 55.5th %ile
- \* Minimum: 12th %ile
- \* Maximum: 99th %ile

#### Class of 2025

- \* Mean: 57.9th %ile

- HSPT– Online registration portal to register for test Opens September 9, 2025.
  - Students rank their three choices of high schools; this information is provided to SUS by the AOB and allows SUS to release student records to the high schools -- Only these schools will receive the student's scores.
     [4th & 5th choices may be selected for fee of \$10 each]
  - Wednesday, November 19 -- AT SUS!
  - □ Fee paid online
  - Deadline for accommodations (i.e. extended time, small group, etc.) is 10/31 -- documentation MUST be uploaded to testing website


#### Non-Catholic, private schools

- > Separate referral forms are required
  - Must complete a release of records with Ms. Susan
  - All referral forms are processed through Ms. Susan
- Academic records are sent in the same manner as for Catholic schools.
- SUS will process these referrals and applications AFTER the Catholic school referrals are completed -usually in January.

# Tuition AssistanceScholarships
