HEALTH UPDATES



As always, we are engaged in a partnership to maintain the health of our entire community. Parents and caregivers are responsible to monitor the health of their student(s) prior to coming to school.

Questions about possible symptoms or exposures should be reported to the school nurse as soon as the situation unfolds. Notification of an exposure or of

a positive test result should be communicated directly to the school nurse by

email at health@stursula.org or by calling 410-665-2472. In the event of a positive COVID-19 test of a student or staff member, the Baltimore County Health Department will be notified and will work with the school nurse and the administration to guide the contact tracing process of identifying those who have been exposed and to make the necessary notification. This team works together under the auspices of the Maryland State Department of Health and the Archdiocese of Baltimore.
