NEW Updated Chromebook Charging Plan Grades 3-8

Students in Grades 3-8 are tasked with charging their Chromebook at night so that they are prepared for school each day. If students do not charge their Chromebook, they can ask their teacher to allow them to charge it at lunch. Please note that some students, particularly those with Chromebooks labeled A, B, G, or H, have some of our older devices that don't hold a charge as long. These students should check their Chromebook prior to lunch to see if a charge is needed.

If students do not charge their devices, and do not put them on the charger at lunch, they may be not being able to use their device for the rest of the day. Work may need to be made up at home. This will ensure that they start charging their device at home.
