NEW Emergency and Weather Related Closings & Delays

Saint Ursula School follows Baltimore County Public Schools for weather related decisions including cancellation of all after school activities. You may also receive notification from our school email system, Swift K12. Please do

not call the school or parish office about school closings. If Baltimore County Schools are previously scheduled to be closed on an inclement weather day, check WBAL Radio/TV for Saint Ursula School announcements, or check the website. If there is an hour late opening, school opens at 8:45 a.m. If there is a two hour late opening, school opens at 9:45 a.m. If there is a 2-hour late opening on a scheduled half-day, school will go full day with a dismissal at 2:50 p.m.
