#### Here is an update on our current COVID protocols.

As of February 1st, the Baltimore County Executive announced that the masking mandate would be lifted.

With the lifting of the masking requirement in the County, here are the updated COVID protocols for our parish community:

1) Masks are NOT required but are strongly recommended for all individuals.
