Saint Angela Merici



Angela Merici (21 March 1474 – 27 January 1540) was an Italian religious educator, who is honored as a saint by the Roman Catholic Church. She founded the Company of St. Ursula in 1535 in Brescia, in which women dedicated their lives to the service of the Church through the education of girls. From this organization later sprang the monastic Order of Ursulines, whose nuns established places of prayer and learning throughout Europe and, later, worldwide, most notably in North America.

Please be reminded that the Nurse's Office has moved to the bottom floor of the convent.



6 Week Bible Study


Weekly Meetings held in the School Convent Wednesdays (3/9 - 4/13) at 7 p.m.
