Saint Jean Baptiste de la Salle



St. Jean was born in France in 1651. After he completed his studies, he renounced his wealth and abandoned his family home to move in with teachers and form a community that became known as the Brothers of the Christian Schools. His work quickly spread throughout France with the founding of schools in 22 cities. After his death, his work continued to spread across the globe with De La Salle schools being represented today in 81 countries.
