## SAINT OF THE WEEK

### *Saint Julie Billiart*



Born in Cuvilly, France, into a family of well-to-do farmers, young Marie Rose Julie Billiart showed an early interest in religion and in helping the sick and poor. A mysterious illness overtook her when she was about 30, leaving her paralyzed. As time passed and Julie continued her mobile life, she made the acquaintance of an aristocratic woman, Françoise Blin de Bourdon, who shared Julie's interest in teaching the faith. In 1803, the two women began the Institute of Notre Dame, which was dedicated to the education of the poor, young Christian girls, and the training of catechists. The following year the first Sisters of Notre Dame made their vows. St. Julie's charism, is expressed in her words: "Oh! How good is the good God."

## **NEW** Mercy High School Summer Camps

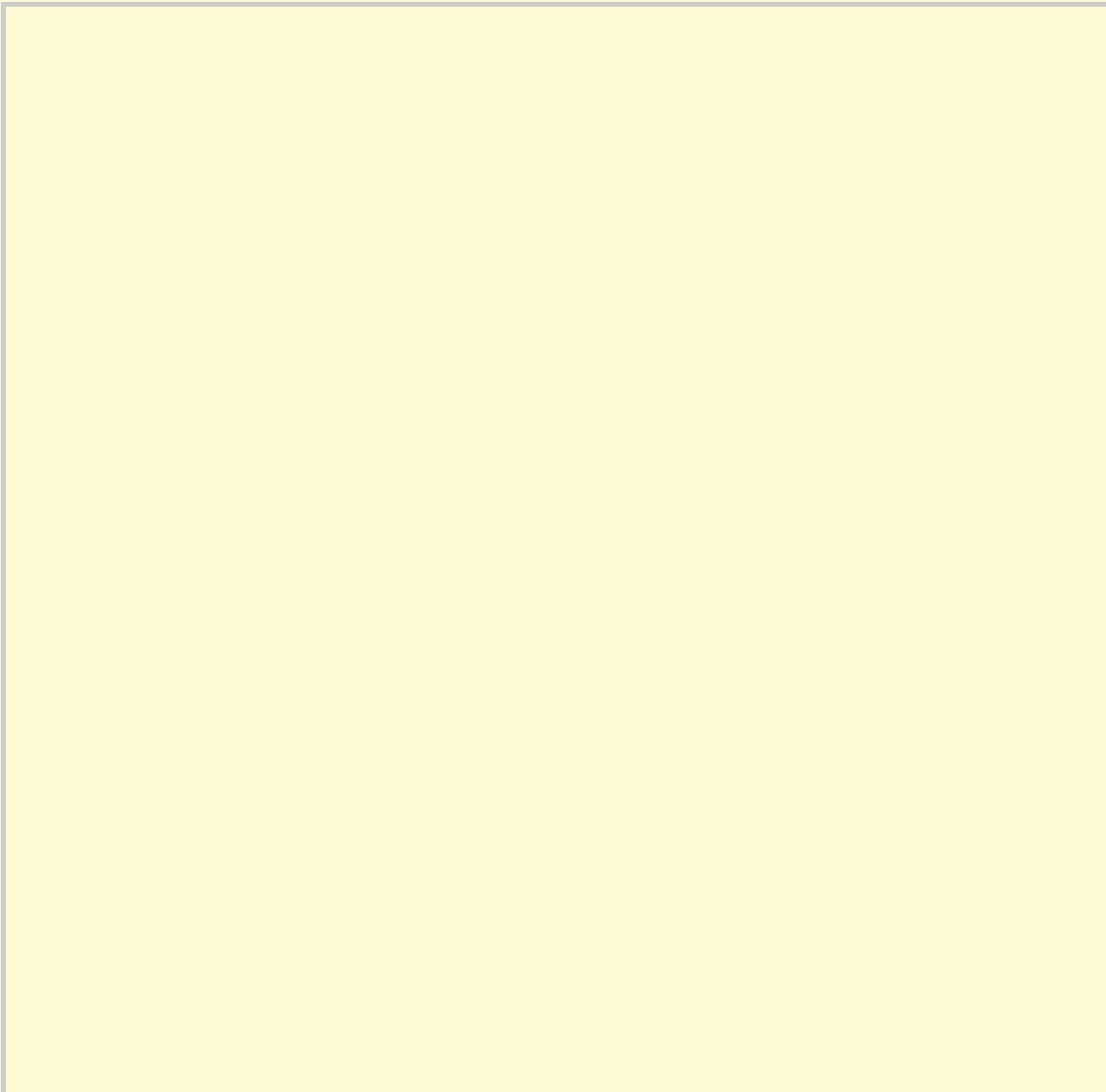
