SAINT OF THE WEEK

Saint Kateri Tekakwitha



St. Kateri Tekakwitha is the first Native American to be recognized as a saint by the Catholic Church. She was born in 1656, in the Mohawk village of Ossernenon. She contracted smallpox as a four-year-old child which scarred her skin. The scars were a source of humiliation in her youth. At age 19, Kateri Tekakwitha converted to Catholicism. Sadly, just five years after her conversion to Catholicism, she became ill and passed away at age 24. It is said that, at her death, her scars diminished, and her face was radiant and beautiful. St. Kateri Tekakwitha was canonized by Pope Benedict XVI on Oct. 21, 2012. She is the patroness of ecology and the environment, people in exile and Native Americans.
