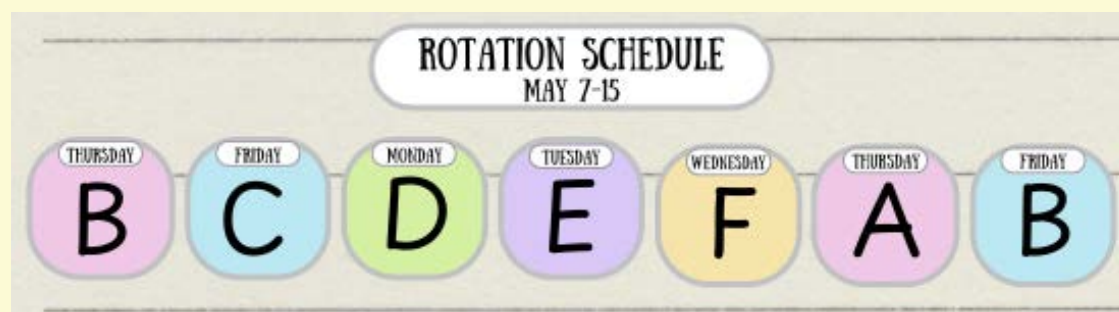
Come join us on Friday, May 15th from 5:30-8:00 p.m. for Food Truck Night hosted by the Cultural Diversity Committee.
