Saint Christopher



Saint Christopher is a legendary martyr of the early church. He is the patron saint of travelers and, beginning in the 20th century, of motorists. He is the hero of many legends, which represent him as a giant who, after being converted, devoted his life to carrying travelers across a river. One day a small child asked to be transported, and in the middle of the river the child became so heavy that Christopher staggered under the burden, complained of the weight, and was told that he had borne upon his back the world and Him who created it. Hence, Christopher (Greek: "Christ-Bearer") is generally represented in art carrying the Christ Child on his back.
