




#### SAINT OF THE WEEK

# **COVID-19 Testing**

The Archdiocese of Baltimore Department of Catholic Schools has asked us to pass along the instructions for a new, updated COVID Testing Consent Form. Please Note: If you had previously filled out this form for the 2021-22 school year, you WILL need to complete this

form again for your child to be tested.

The COVID-19 Testing Program is entirely voluntary and meant to provide a safe, convenient and prompt means of having your child tested should COVID-19 symptoms arise at school. The Testing Consent Form, along with Fact Sheets on the COVID-19 Rapid and PCR tests, provides details on how testing will be conducted and how the test results and information will be shared as part of this Program. This form must be completed in order for your child to be tested by our school nurse for COVID-19.

To facilitate your review of the Program and approval to participate, we have created a COVID-19 Testing Consent Form on your child's "SchoolAdmin Enrollment Checklist" for you to complete. The checklist can be accessed via this link: <a href="https://stursula.schooladminonline.com/portal">https://stursula.schooladminonline.com/portal</a>. Once you are logged into your SchoolAdmin account, please click the blue "View Checklist" button. The portal will indicate that you have no forms to complete, but the testing form is listed as optional, so it will be listed at the bottom of the Enrollment
