## Dear Parents,

First I want to thank you so much for all your support during Catholic Schools Week. Many of you assisted with our highly successful Open House in a variety of ways. The number of visitors the last three days has been so appreciated, knowing how this may impact work schedules. Today, pajama day and 8<sup>th</sup> grade sharing, will continue our focus on our students. Finally we will have the traditional Spirit Day tomorrow. Students are encouraged to wear blue and gold or an "SUS" team shirt (basketball, track and field, soccer). Remember that dismissal tomorrow will be at 12:10.

We have extended the deadline for re-registration until tomorrow. As stated earlier we had a highly successful Open House and to date have nearly 90 new applications.
