## Dear Parents,

THANK YOU so much for making the first day of school run so smoothly. We do need to remind all parents that no child should be dropped off prior to 7:45. There is no supervision until that time. Also remember not to park on St. John's lot and walk across Neifeld. If you need to walk your child, please park on the church lot and cross with the crossing guards.

Our enrollment continues to grow. We currently have 639 students and are continuing to have inquiries almost daily. Please reach out to parents especially during dismissal, since that can be overwhelming to a new parent (as many of you may recall!).

We are actively looking for the best teacher for our middle school science and math position. In the meantime we welcome back Mrs. Diane Howe who will sub until the new hire is in place.

The Parent/Student Handbook came home this week with the youngest child. It is imperative that you read it thoroughly since many changes have occurred. One particular change pertains to tardiness. A child will be marked tardy if he/she is not in their classroom by the 8:10 bell. So if your child is on the second or third floors please make sure you drop them off with enough time left to get to their classroom prior to the 8:10 bell. We will have a month of grace prior to actually marking students late who arrive by 8:15 but after 8:10. In addition the Acceptable Use Policy for Technology is now embedded in the Handbook. The permission is part of the Handbook receipt which must be returned one per family.
