Dear 8th grade families, your child is eligible to register to prepare for Confirmation at St. Ursula Church. The Sacrament of Confirmation celebrates the fullness of the Holy Spirit conferred upon the individual at Baptism. It is not a rite of passage or the end of faith formation. It is about the individual's readiness for the beginning of a life-long faith journey. A journey that takes a path to a deeper relationship with Jesus and full, active participation in parish life.

**As you and your child discern about Confirmation readiness, you and your child should reflect on his/her ability to do the following:**

- Approach the Confirmation journey with an open mind and heart.
- Attend and fully participate in all Confirmation Prep sessions and activities.
- Attend Mass every Sunday and Holy Days of Obligation.
- Receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation before Confirmation Mass.
- Accept more responsibility in the family, parish, and community.
- Commit to daily prayer, especially for growth in faith, hope and love.
- Select a Sponsor who is a Confirmed Catholic, who is 16 years or older, routinely attends Mass, and is a good Catholic role-model.
