As part of our PBIS program, students who have received *Child of God blue slips* will also be acknowledged. Blue slips will be returned so students can share them proudly with their families.


All students receiving either a *Child of God* certificate or a blue slip will enjoy a special out-of-uniform day on Wednesday, October 1st.

Rules

- Posters must reflect the theme of As Children of God, We Are Pilgrims of Hope.
- Posters must be your own, original work, this includes the design, layout, slogan(other than the theme) and any images used. You MAY NOT print out anything (images, words, etc.) and glue it on the posters.
- Posters should be approximately 11 x 14 inches in size (legal paper size).
- · Posters can be in color or black and white.
- Your name and homeroom should be neatly written on the back of the poster.
- All posters are due on Wednesday, October 8, 2025. Late posters will not be accepted.

Judging Criteria

Posters will be judged in two grade divisions, Grades 3-5 and Grades 6-8 Posters will be judged on the following criteria:

- Theme: How well is the theme of As Children of God, We Are Pilgrims of Hope represented on the poster?
- Visuals/Neatness: How well do the images on the poster relate to the theme? Is the poster neat?
- Overall Impact: How well did the poster grab your attention? How effective was it in causing you to reflect on the theme?


NEW Announcements Regarding the Reception of Sacraments at St. Ursula
